We are George's friend from Yacht Constance that was kept on the hard in Shearwater (North Coast of BC) for almost four years because of Covid. George has forwarded us your kind answer to him offering us to get in touch with you which we do.

After two weeks of final jobs and checks, Constance was set back in water at the end of June and she's now proved she's fit to sail. We crossed Queen Charlotte Sound last week and are presently sailing along the West coast of Vancouver Island, heading towards Victoria to check out of Canada before August 15<sup>th</sup>.

From there on, we'll have two weeks to either haul out or get a moorage in Washington State to fly back at the end of August and get back to France. So far, our best offer is in Bellingham at the Landings at Colony Wharf for a haul out and storage on the hard.



We haven't yet finalized any arrangement as we're still looking for a better option, meaning a safe place at a reasonable cost.
